The United States Postal service recently mailed the postcard shown below to every household in the United States. **Some of the information in this mailer is inaccurate for New Jersey voters.**

**In New Jersey:**

- Mail-in ballots will be automatically sent to active voters who are already registered by October 5. **There is NO NEED TO REQUEST A BALLOT.** To check if you are an active registered voter, visit <https://voter.svrs.nj.gov/registration-check> or call your county's Election Office.
- The League of Women Voters highly recommends that you **VOTE EARLY!** Fill your ballot out immediately upon receipt and **return it before October 20.**
- **NO STAMP IS NEEDED** on the vote by mail return envelope.

If you vote by mail, we're committed to providing you a secure, effective way to deliver your ballot. Use this checklist to prepare:


- Start today. Give yourself and your election officials ample time to complete the process.
- Rules and dates vary by state, so contact your election board to confirm. Find links at [usps.com/votinginfo](https://usps.com/votinginfo).
- Request your mail-in ballot (often called "absentee" ballot) at least 15 days before Election Day.
- Once received, follow the instructions. Add postage to the return envelope if needed.
- We recommend you mail your ballot at least 7 days before Election Day.
