

## Voter Registration Fact Sheet – Fall 2021

This is an important election year for New Jersey, which is electing its Governor, all of its state legislators, and many county and municipal offices.

Election Day is **November 2, 2021**

The last day to register to vote in this election is **October 12, 2021**.

### Requirements for Registering and Voting

- You may register to vote if you are at least 17 years old and a U.S. citizen.
- You may vote in an election if you are at least 18 years old by election day and have registered to vote.
- If you have changed your address or name since you last registered, you must complete a voter registration form to update your information.

### How to Register to Vote or Change Registration Information

If you need to register to vote or change your information, you have two options:

- Use NJ's on-line voter registration system. It may be accessed via this QR code.
