League of Women Voters of the Greater New Brunswick Area and Together Edison Censure Edison Mayoral Candidate Keith Hahn for Violating Mayoral Forum Rules

The League of Women Voters of the Greater New Brunswick Area and Together Edison, the co-sponsors of the September 26, 2021 Edison Mayoral Forum, announce a censure of Mayoral Candidate W. Keith Hahn for violating the Candidate Agreement he signed prior to the forum prohibiting any use of edited or excerpted forum material without the express consent of the forum sponsors. The terms of the Agreement were also announced near the opening of the forum.

Specifically, the candidate has violated a provision of the Agreement that *“any use of the League name or of footage or other materials from the debate in campaign materials, literature or advertising of any kind, including Internet, cable or television is not authorized by the League of Women Voters.”*

The League of Women Voters of the Greater New Brunswick Area and the League of Women Voters of New Jersey have asked the candidate to remove the offending material. The candidate has not removed the content. Accordingly, the League is releasing this public statement regarding the violation.
