



Requirements for Registering and Voting

- You may register to vote if you are at least seventeen years old and a U.S. citizen.
- You may vote in an election if you are at least eighteen years old by election day and have registered to vote.
- If you have changed your address or name since you last registered, you must complete a voter registration form to update your information.

How to Register to Vote or Change Registration Information

If you need to register to vote or change your information, you have two options:

- Fill out and mail a paper registration form.
- Use NJ's on-line voter registration system. It may be accessed via this QR code.



****IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT SIGNATURES ****

You will be asked for your signature when you vote in any election and it must match the signature on your voter registration. To avoid future voting problems, do one of the following:

- Sign legibly on the paper registration form.
- If registering online, use the option of uploading a photograph of your legible signature.

If your signature has changed since you last registered, you should submit a new voter registration form with your current signature and the Signature Update box checked.

Deadlines for submitting voter registration forms.

- To vote in the June 7 primary, you must register on or before May 17, 2022
- To vote in the Nov 8 General election, you must register on or before October 18, 2022.
