

2023 Primary Election

This year we will be voting for all members of the New Jersey State Senate and General Assembly. There are also races at the county, municipal and school district levels.

There are three ways to vote in this Primary Election:

1. Vote by Mail (VBM)

- You must apply for a VBM Ballot by May 30, 2023.
- Applications to apply for a VBM Ballot may be found here <https://www.state.nj.us/state/elections/vote-by-mail.shtml> - applications
- After sending the application, you will receive a ballot in the mail.
- Your completed ballot must either be returned to a ballot drop box or mailed to arrive at the county clerk's office by 8:00 PM on June 6, 2023.

2. Vote at your Polling Place on Election Day, June 6, 2023 between 6 AM and 8 PM.

3. Vote early at an Early Voting polling place, Friday, June 2 through Sunday, June 4, 2023. Early voting hours are 10 AM to 8 PM on Friday and Saturday, and 10 AM to 6 PM on Sunday.

Voting in a Primary Election

You must be affiliated with either the Democratic or Republican Party to vote in their party's primary. If you are currently unaffiliated, you can declare an affiliation and vote at the polls on Primary Election day.
