

2024 General Election

This year in NJ we will be voting for a President, one Senator, and all Congressional Representatives. There are also races at the county, municipal and school district levels.

Election Day is **November 5, 2024** The last day to register to vote is **October 15, 2024**

There are three ways to vote in the General Election:

1. Vote by Mail (VBM)

- The deadline to apply by mail for a VBM ballot is October 29. The deadline to apply in person for a VBM ballot is November 4 by 3:00 PM.

 <u>Vote by Mail Application</u>
- After sending in your application, you will receive a ballot in the mail.
- Your completed ballot must either be **returned to a Secure Ballot Drop Box** in your county of residence **or mailed** to arrive at the county clerk's office by 8:00 PM on November 5, 2024.

- 2. Vote at your Polling Place on Election Day, November 5, 2024 between 6 AM and 8 PM.

3. Vote early at an Early Voting polling place, Saturday, October 26 through Sunday, November 3, 2024. Early voting hours are 10 AM to 8 PM on weekdays and Saturday, and 10 AM to 6 PM on Sunday.
